The SSAT Postgraduate Course will be held in conjunction with Digestive Disease Week® (DDW), the combined Annual Meetings of the AASLD, AGA, ASGE, and the SSAT. The date of DDW® is May 20-24, 2006.

### **COURSE GOAL**

This course will discuss a multidisciplinary approach to the management of a number of surgical disorders of the gastrointestinal tract, including rectal cancer, gastric cancer, GI tumors, Crohn's disease, intestinal failure, and gastroesophageal reflux disease. The goal of the course will be to provide the participants with current management recommendations from specialists in surgery, gastroenterology and radiology. In doing so, the faculty hopes to encourage collaboration amongst specialists to optimize outcomes in patient care.

### **FORMAT**

The course will be divided into six sessions (Rectal Cancer, Gastric Cancer, GI Tumors, Crohn's Disease, Intestinal Failure, and Gastroesophageal Reflux Disease), each with four specific topics of interest to clinicians and to surgeons. A working lunch with video session is also planned. Presentations will emphasize a multidisciplinary understanding and approach problem management. A question-and-answer session will follow the speaker presentations, encouraging discussion among faculty and attendees.

### **ACCREDITATION**

This activity will be planned and implemented in accordance with the Essential Areas and Policies of the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education through the joint sponsorship of the American College of Surgeons and the Society for Surgery of the Alimentary Tract.
